

## **Medicare Regulations**

Century City Physical Therapy, Inc. is a certified Medicare facility and therefore has regulations to be able to submit medical claims for reimbursement. We would appreciate your help in compliance with these regulations.

- 1. A patient must be seen by their referring MD every month to renew their prescription. Medicare requires this to be done in person not by phone or by FAX.
- 2. The physical therapist must be able to document that the patient has medical necessity for physical therapy and is not being seen for maintenance care.
- 3. Patients need to keep regular physical therapy appointments to establish patient compliance.
- 4. Please note that Medicare will not allow you to have outpatient physical therapy as well as treatment at *another* facility or *any* form of Home Health services concurrently. If there were prior Home Health services, CCPT must verify that the patient has been discharged from all services. This must be done before the patient can be seen by outpatient physical therapy (Century City Physical Therapy)
- 5. If it is rendered by Medicare that the services Century City Physical Therapy provides are not covered by Medicare due to any past contingency between the patient and provider, the patient must agree to pay the services that Medicare does not cover.
